




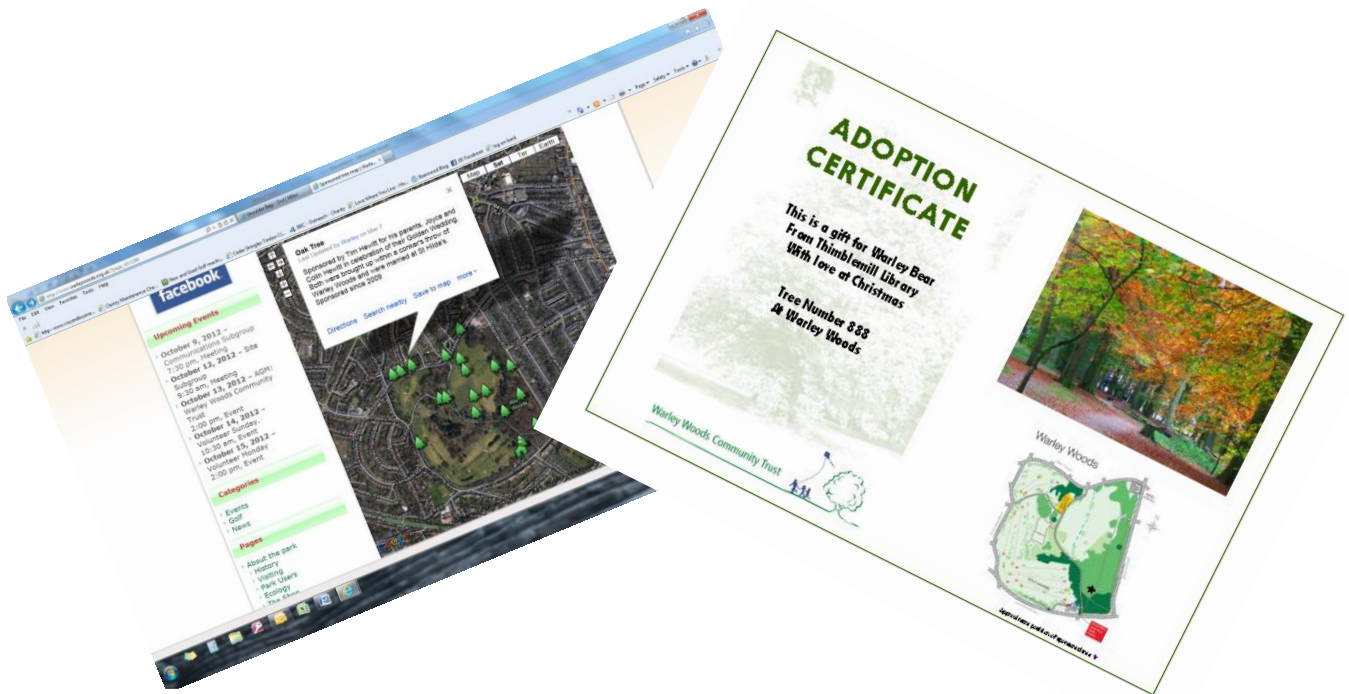


Adopt a Tree in Warley Woods

You can choose your own tree number or choose one of these

-  One of the **Sessile Oaks** in the oldest part of Warley Woods. Probably the original woodland which has been coppiced at some time in the past. **Tree numbers:** 60 128 73 74 113 226
-  Or one of the **Pedunculate Oaks** in the meadow. **Tree numbers:** 1694 1695 1697 1698 1699
-  One of the **Blue Atlas Cedars** along the main drive. Beautiful and full of character. **Tree numbers:** 1084 1091 1090 1089 1087
-  One of the **Beech trees** in the Humphry Repton landscape – scalloped edge of the meadow. **Tree numbers:** 910 917 928 931 914
-  One of the **evergreen trees** in the Winter Garden (Rose Garden.): **Tree numbers:** 1468 **Scots Pine** 1446 1441 **Dawn Redwood** 1435 **Monkey Puzzle**
-  Or 1425 **Copper Beech**, 1432 **Spanish Oak**

The tree will be adopted for 12 months. There are other ways of supporting Warley Woods, please talk to the Trust Manager about other things you can do.

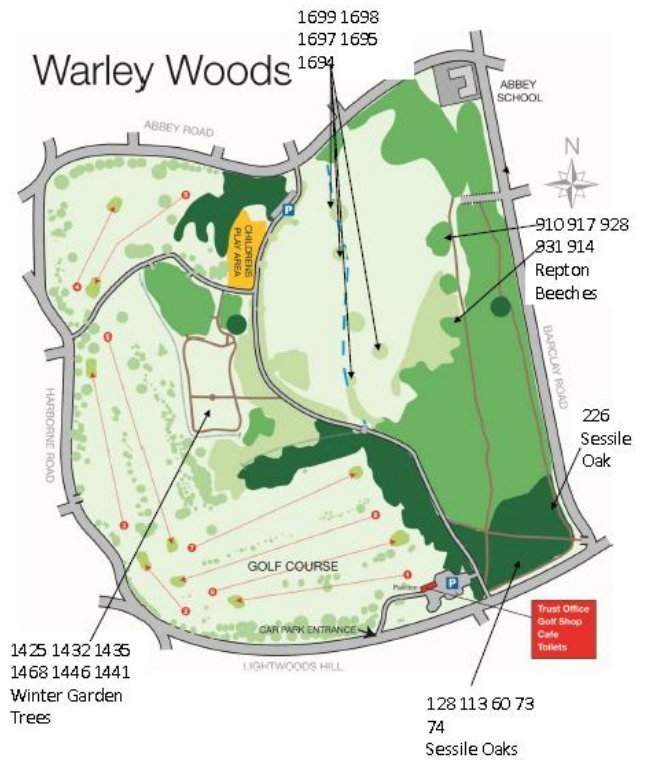
