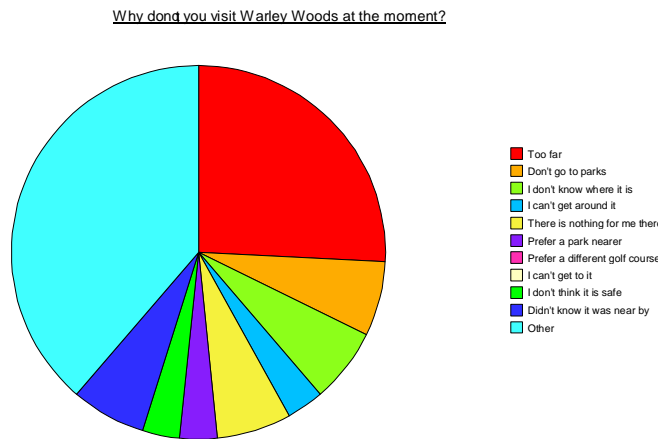

Short of time at the moment, so unable to enjoy park

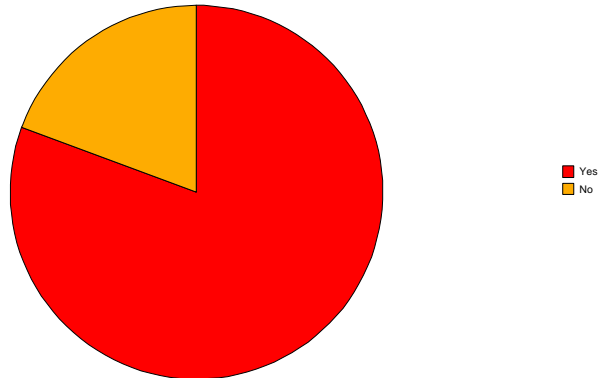

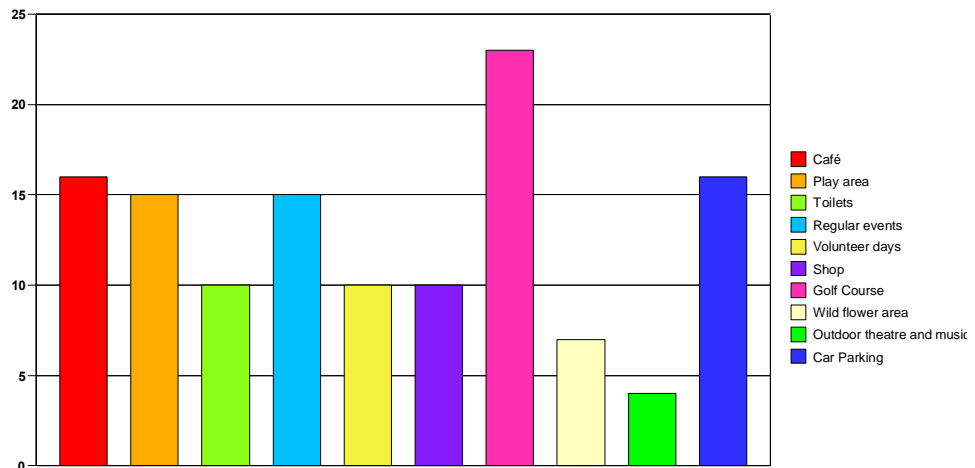

Do you go to parks for events?

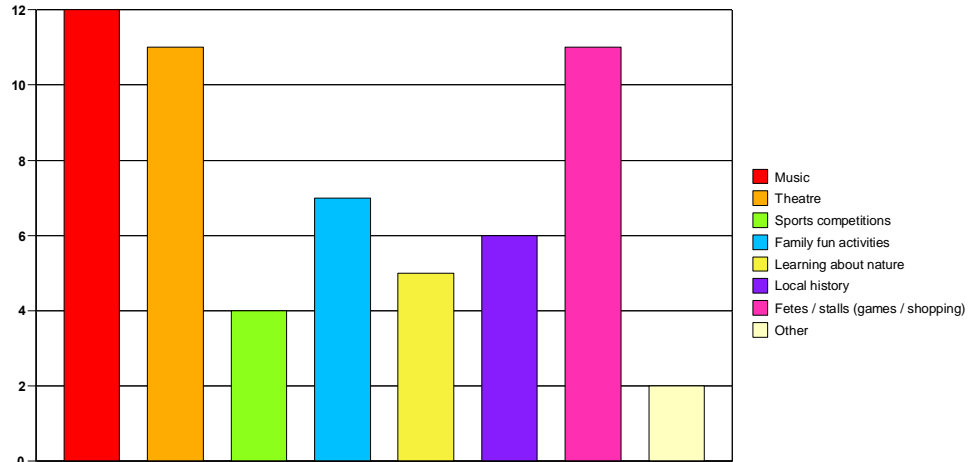

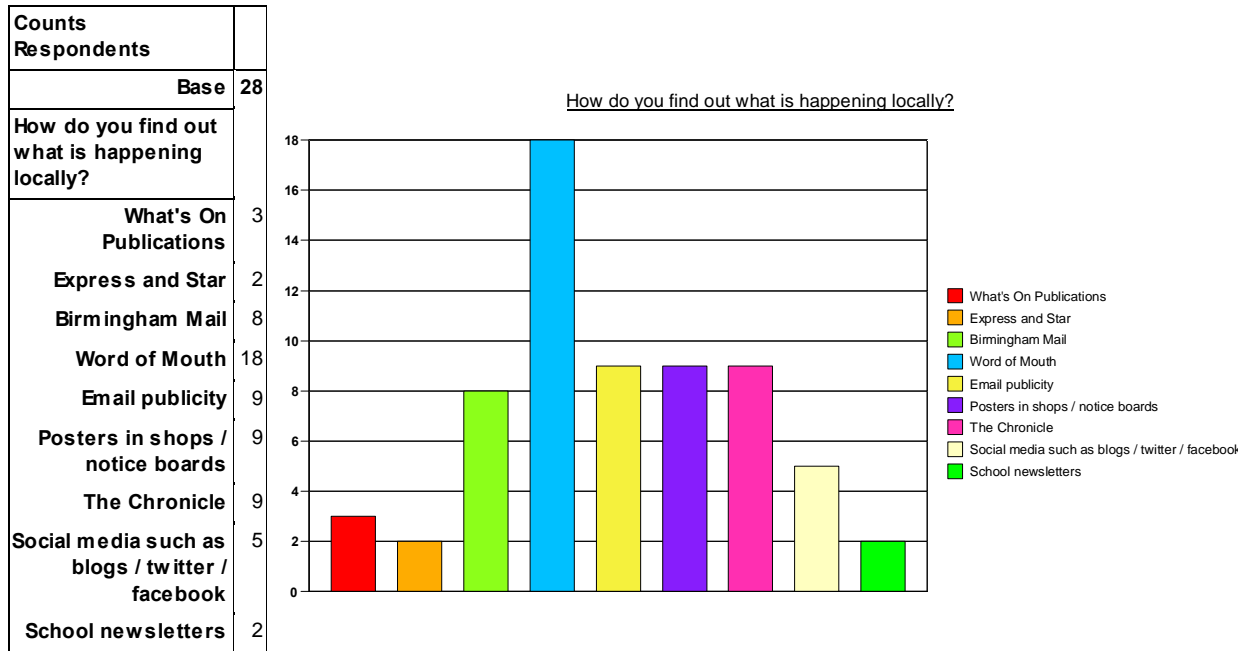

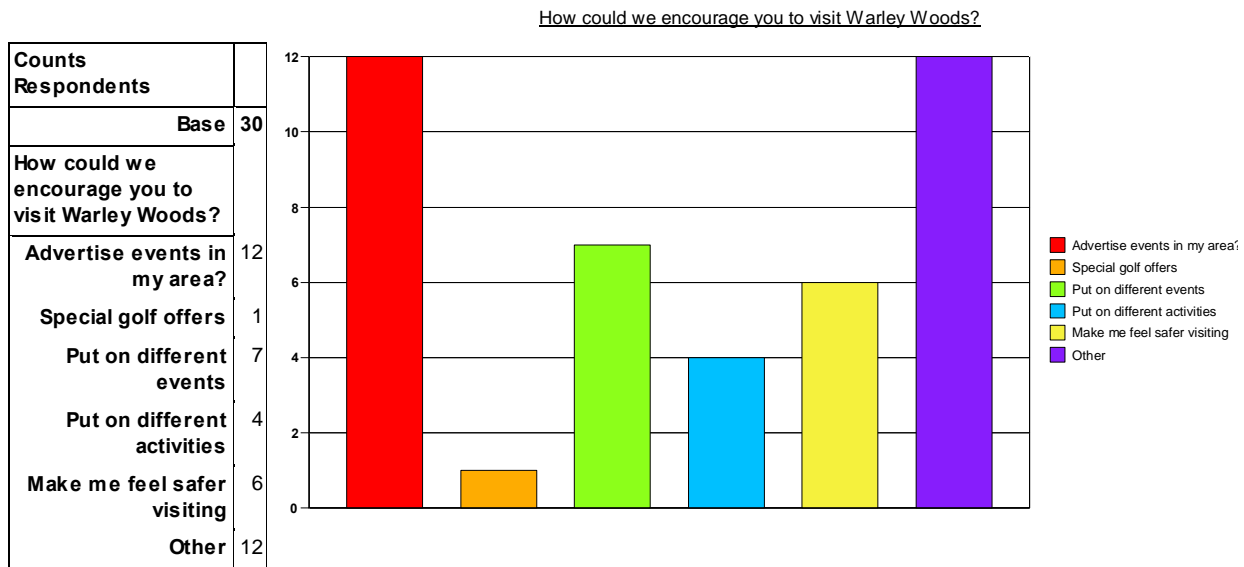

add a lot more variety of plants, have flowerbeds

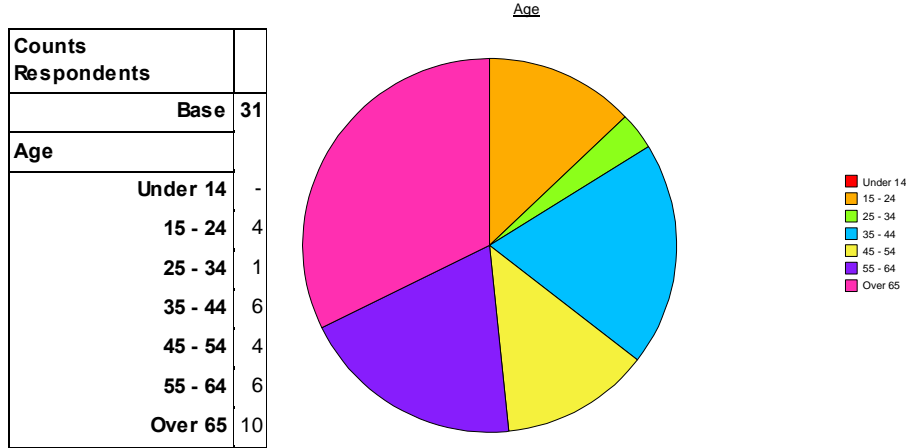
i found out about survey from leaflet at the door. V useful as I dont pass the park

I don't think you can do any more to attract me. I do not have the time.

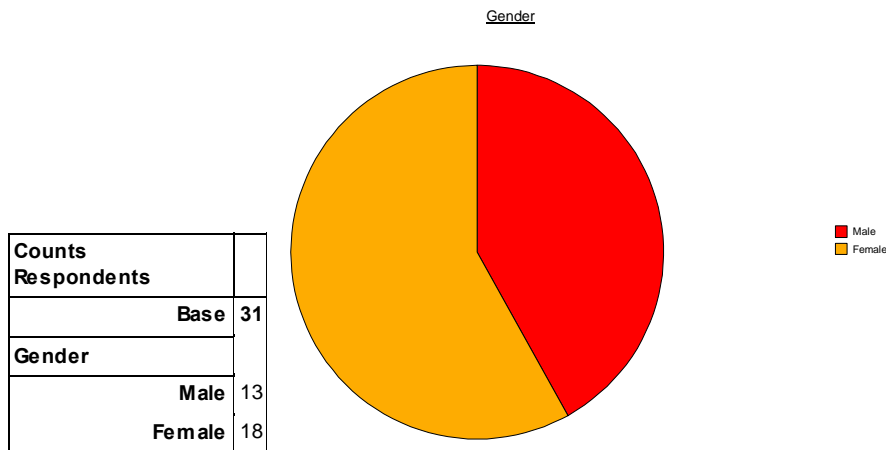

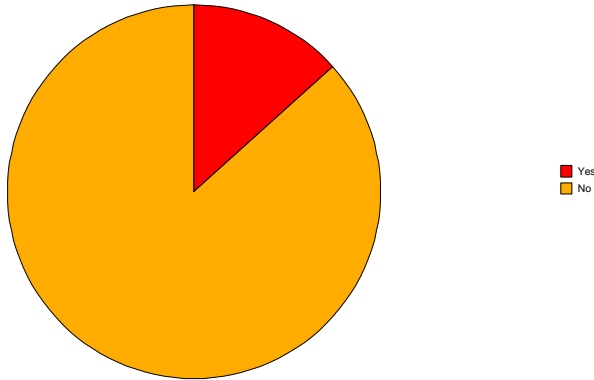

Do you consider yourself to have a disability that may af...

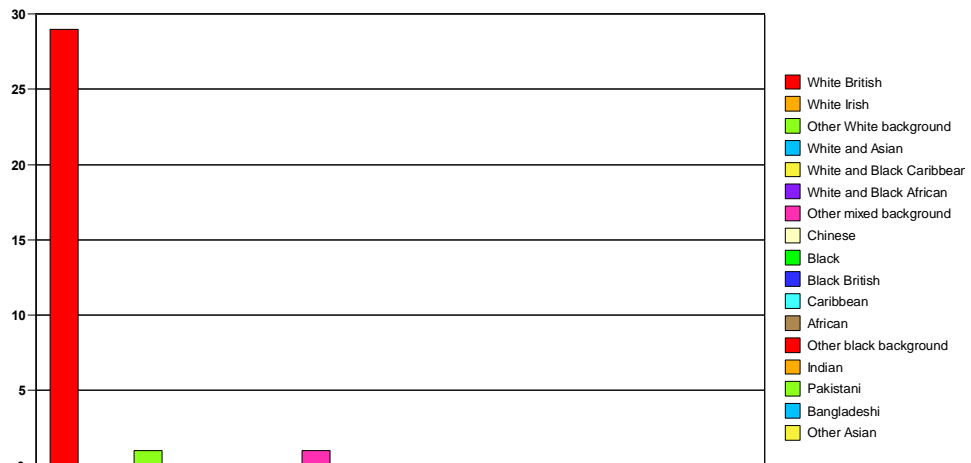
