

Warley Woods Community Trust was formed to secure the restoration, and influence the future running, of Warley Woods park and golf course when it was being neglected by its landowner. This led to the legal handover of the site in 2004 under a 99 year lease, making the Community Trust the first charity in the UK to take on this kind of responsibility. The 100 acre historic urban site incorporates open parkland, woodland and a 9 hole public golf course. The Trust manages and maintains the park, woodland and the pay and play golf course and organises activities which help make the site a pleasure to visit either every day or for a special event. Warley Woods is a fantastic space, well loved and well used by local people. The Community Trust is a registered charity and a unique organisation, providing a growing and evolving service.



Vision

The vision of Warley Woods Community Trust is:

- To secure long-term restoration and care of Warley Woods as a diverse, ecologically rich park and woodland, based on Humphry Repton's original design principles
- To continue the tradition of The People's Park as an accessible, safe, welcoming and healthy environment which is a central focus for the local community
- To draw upon the qualities of this unique landscape to promote recreation, education and pleasure for all

What is membership?

Membership of Warley Woods Community Trust shows that you are committed to the vision of the Trust which is about preserving and improving Warley Woods. Membership entitles you to four copies of the Trust's newsletter, The LEAFlet, each year. You are also invited to attend and vote at the AGM and to stand as a Trustee. This spreads the word about what is going on and gives them the opportunity to get involved if they wish. Our membership numbers show that local people care. As a registered charity, donations above the membership rates are extremely welcome. Some members pay their membership monthly or annually by standing order which ensures membership is automatically renewed.



How else can you help?

Warley Woods Community Trust is run by local residents who, as volunteers, are involved in every aspect of what goes on. This includes the management of the park and the golf course, helping maintain them and organising activities and events. You don't have to be a member to volunteer but the more volunteers there are, the more beautiful the site becomes and the more the Trust can achieve.
